

Big Sandy Area Child Advocacy Center, Inc.
Annual Report
June 2004-July 2005

It is the mission of the Big Sandy Area Child Advocacy Center to lessen the trauma experienced by the child victim of abuse by providing a child-friendly center with a warm, home like, supportive environment where intervention efforts can be offered to reduce the stress to the abused child and parent or adult caregiver. The Center further commits to raise public awareness for the need to stop and prevent physical and sexual abuse against innocent children.

The opening of the doors of the Big Sandy Area Child Advocacy Center, Inc. to its home, Judi's Place for Kids, in July 2001, many direct services have been provided to work toward its mission. Please find below a summary of our work this year.

- The BSACAC served 97 unduplicated alleged child victims of abuse in the following age categories:

Age	Number Served
0-5	33
6-12	39
13-17	25

- Each of these 97 victims received a forensic interview by a licensed psychologist with specialized training in interviewing children in a non-biased, non-leading, legally defensible manner.
- The Center also served 97 adults who were non-offending caregivers of these child victims.
- The Center staff responded to 40 crisis calls, requiring immediate action by Center staff on behalf of a victim.
- The Center staff provided 173 victim advocacy services.
- The Center provided 21 comprehensive child sexual abuse medical exams on-site. These examinations are provided by pediatricians with specialized training and utilizing

- specialized equipment. Additionally, the child victims are screened by a licensed mental health provider for mental health needs.
- The Center staff attended 35 meetings of multi-disciplinary teams on child sexual abuse throughout the region. These meetings bring together all of the community's professionals involved in criminal child abuse cases to ensure that each child's case is reviewed and that appropriate actions are coordinated.
 - Forty-nine mental health sessions were provided on-site to 28 child victims through a qualified mental health therapist from Mountain Comprehensive Care Center.
 - 19 training programs were offered in the community to increase awareness regarding the Center's services and the topic of child abuse. These 19 trainings impacted 359 participants.
 - The Center benefited from 430 hours of volunteer service, primarily through internship opportunities with the local institutions for higher education.
